The State Government will subsidise the development of new tourist facilities at Bruno Bay, Cobdogla, the House of Assembly Cember for Chaffey, Mr. Reg Curren, announced today.

He said the Fremier, Mr. Dunstan, had told him a grant of \$800 had been made to the Barmera District Council to kelp meet the cost of providing a car park, pavilion and picnic area at Bruno Bay.

Er. Gurren said the new area was being developed because a previous popular picnic erea had been set aside as the site of the new pumping station for Cobdogla and Barmere.
