PRESS RELEASE FROM THE HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY MEMBER, MR. BURDON.

11.9.72

Tenders are expected to be called for a further 21 rental houses in Mount Gambier this month, the House of Assembly Member for the city, Mr. Burdon, announced today.

Mr. Burdon said he had been told this during discussions with the Premier about Mount Gambier housing when Mr. Dunstan visited the city last weekend.

Mr. Burdon said the Premier had told him that the Trust was aware of the high demand for rental housing in Mount Gambier. There were already under contract 28 villa flats for rental and 18 maisonette type units still to be completed.

Some 38 single units have been contracted and are still to be completed.

Mr. Dunstan, who is also Housing Minister, had said it was expected that about twenty five of these would become available for rental.
