PRESS RELEASE FROM THE PREMIER, MR. DUNSTAN.

MILANG TOURIST SUBSIDY.

11.9.72

New tourist developments on the lake foreshore at Milang will be subsidised by the State Government, the Premier, Mr. Dunstan, announced today.

Mr. Dunstan, who is also Minister for Tourism, said the estimated cost of the first stage of these developments was \$20,000.

The Government has agreed to provide up to \$9,850 to the District Council of Strathalbyn to help meet the cost.

"The foreshore area has tremendous tourist development potential and the plans prepared are most impressive", Mr. Dunstan said.

The work proposed at present involves the construction of a tourist road and kerbing estimated to cost \$11,700, and car parks, caravan park, roads and lawns to cost about \$8,000.

Mr. Dunstan said the new project was very worthwhile and would be a great boost to tourism in the area.
