An Educational Project Centre will be opened at Beulah Road, Norwood in February next year, the Premier and House of Assembly Member for Norwood, Mr. Dunstan, announced today.

The Centre, a joint venture of the Department for Community Welfare and the S.A. Education Department, will cater for children with social behaviour problems who are temporarily excluded from a normal school environment.

Mr. Dunstan said children between eight and fifteen years who were assessed as suitable to benefit from attending the Centre, would be referred there by the Juvenile Court, Juvenile Aid Panels and by contact between the Department for Community Welfare, parents and children.

Children would attend the Centre on a daily basis to modify their present behaviour patterns, and so reduce the threat of delinquent behaviour, Mr. Dunstan said.

A team approach by group workers and teachers from both Departments would be used to plan individual programmes for children at the Centre.

Emphasis would be on the improvement of social skills and learning that school could be enjoyable, helpful and applicable to everyday living, Mr. Dunstan said.
