PRESS RELEASE FROM THE PREMIER (MR DUNSTAN)

CHRISTISON PARK SUBSIDY

4.9.73

The State Government will help subsidise the cost of installing an effluent pumping system at Christison Park, Clare.

Announcing this today, the Premier (Mr Dunstan) said the Government would provide \$450 towards installing the pumping system.

The pumping system was needed to remove effluent from toilets at the park to a soakage area.

Mr Dunstan said the District Council of Clare estimated that the total cost of the system would be \$925.
