PRESS RELEASE FROM THE PREMIER (MR DUNSTAN)

PORT WILLUNGA CAR PARK SUBSIDY

4.9.73

A protection rail is to be installed along the cliff frontage at the Port Willunga car park, the Premier and Minister of Tourism (Mr Dunstan) said today.

Mr Dunstan said the Government had agreed to provide \$500 to the District Council of Willunga for the cost of installing the safety fence.

He said danger currently existed at the car park because of the slope of the land towards the cliff top.

Several accidents had occurred at the site when parked vehicles had moved off and dropped over the cliff.

"The new safety rail will prevent accidents like this from happening", he said.
