The Premier, Mr. Dunstan, today condemned suggestions that the Palestine Liberation Organisation should be permitted representation in Australia.

The suggestion was made at the weekend by a prominent member of the Victorian A.L.P., Mr. W.H. Hartley. He proposed that this be done through the establishment of an information office of the League of Arab States.

"I am completely opposed to any action which could involve Australia in the terror and bloodshed which is such a tragic feature of the Middle East conflict.

"I do not believe the establishment of such an office would be in the best interests of the Australian people and would certainly resist any proposal to establish one in South Australia.

"There can be no peace in the Middle East without admitting the existence and continuance of Israel. Furthering propaganda in Australia by one organisation committed to the elimination of Israel and its population is something no Labor man should be involved in", the Premier said.
