UNEMPLOYMENT RELIEF SCHEME

The Premier, Mr. Dunstan, today released details of the allocation of an extra \$2.1M for the South Australian Government's Unemployment Relief Scheme.

Mr. Dunstan said Councils in Adelaide and throughout the rest of the State would receive the money shortly for projects which would reduce unemployment in their areas.

The \$2.1M is in addition to money provided in the Budget for unemployment and will provide employment for almost 1,600 people until early next year.

"The money will be used for mainly labour-intensive schemes which will benefit local communities, as well as providing employment during the particularly difficult Christmas period.

"Community facilities such as more footpaths, parks and reserves, drainage and road works, will be constructed as a result of these extra funds".

Mr. Dunstan said the areas which would receive grants were : Adelaide Metropolitan Area, Mount Gambier, Port Pirie, Port Augusta, Whyalla, Port Lincoln, Naracoorte and Millicent.
