

## Viewing zipped Smart Casual modules on various devices

The first 3 options below describe how to start with a zipped Smart Casual module then allow viewing offline.

### 1. For a Microsoft Windows operating system:

- 1.1. Download the zip file using your web browser (eg. in some browsers, right click on the filename then click "Save Link As").
- 1.2. Unzip/extract the file by using a Windows unzip utility, or a third party program such as 7-Zip. You can often do this by right clicking on the zip file (using File Explorer or Windows Explorer) then clicking on one of the "Extract" options. Although the resulting folder may contain hundreds of files, you will typically only need to access one of the HTML files in the top-level folder.
- 1.3. With File Explorer or Windows Explorer, navigate into the folder you just extracted and find the file "**story\_html5.html**". Double click on this file to open it using your default web browser. The Smart Casual module should appear ok in any web browser which supports HTML5, eg. modern versions of Google Chrome, Firefox or Microsoft Edge.

### 2. For an Apple Mac 10.x, Linux or other computer operating system

- 2.1. Follow the same principles as for section 1. The Smart Casual module should appear ok in any web browser which supports HTML5, eg. modern versions of Google Chrome, Firefox or Safari.

### 3. For an Android tablet

- 3.1. Follow steps 1.1 and 1.2 above.
- 3.2. Copy the extracted folder to your Android tablet (eg. via USB cable). You will probably need to store the folder on internal storage as some web browsers are not permitted to open files stored on an external SD card.
- 3.3. Use Google Chrome or other modern HTML5 web browser to **open "story\_html5.html"**. Eg. On several Samsung devices, for internal storage path /www/mod1/story\_html5.html, you can access via URL file:///sdcard/www/mod1/story\_html5.html

### 4. Other options

The above options describe how to view Smart Casual modules offline when starting with a zipped file. This section describes options when the contents of an unzipped Smart Casual module is made available via a web server (eg. at <https://smartlawteacher.org/modules/>).

- 4.1. Smart Casual modules can be viewed online by HTML5 web browsers under Windows, Mac, Android and iOS (eg. iPad). Navigate to "story\_html5.html" on the web server.
- 4.2. Smart Casual modules can be viewed online (and offline) via the Articulate Mobile Player app on Android and iOS (eg. iPad). Install the app on your mobile device then navigate to "amplaunch.html" on the web server.
  - 4.2.1. Articulate Mobile Player in Apple iOS 7 or later on iPad
  - 4.2.2. Articulate Mobile Player in Android OS 4.1 or later (optimized for tablets)
- 4.3. Smart Casual modules can be viewed via Internet Explorer 8 or later and Adobe Flash Player 10.3 or later. Navigate to "story.swf" on the web server.
