An Act to continue the Act to provide for the Payment of Members of Parliament.

[Assented to, October 24th, 1890.]

WHEREAS it is desirable to continue the operation of the Act No. 399 of 1887, to provide for the payment of Members of Parliament—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in section 4 of the said Act, No. 399 of 1887, the said Act shall continue in full force and operation until repealed or altered. Act No. 399 of 1887 to continue in force.

2. Except so far as inconsistent therewith, this Act shall be incorporated with the said Act, and shall be read therewith as one Act. Incorporation.

In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
